





It is tough to move past our trauma and continue living our lives. And in moments it feels like it's defining us. We have shown as a team, as an organization, that we can change the narrative and move forward positively.



Before we could rewrite our stuck story, it was important to understand the power of our story. Our stories shaped the way we viewed ourselves and this new space around us. When we experienced this trauma, our story became defeated. However, the power stuck in a negative cycle, causing us to feel powerless and defeated. However, the power to rewrite our story lies within us. We had the ability to change the narrative and create a new, positive story. A challenge each team member accepted with extreme highs and lows. One of the keys to rewriting our stuck story was reframing our perspectives. When we experienced this trauma, it was easy to fall into negative thought patterns and believe that we are powerless to change our situation. The Care and Share team challenged each other to begin reframing our perspectives, rather than our weaknesses and failures. By shifting our perspective we began to see our trauma as a challenge to overcome, rather than a barrier to our success.

I want to take the time to recognize the team I am grateful to be a part of, because I am acutely aware that no achievement is an island. This is not just my success, or the organization's success, this is a shared victory of hard work, dedication and a lifetime of tears for each team member who has fought this journey alongside me. To my team, you are the unsung heroes, the backbone of every challenge and victory, and the courage behind our success. 

Care and Share my home "This is the first time I am speaking a little about myself, and I want to say that it is not very easy. There were always mixed emotions in my marriage after a complicated life full of domestic violence. I decided to end it, but that meant being homeless along with my daughter who was only 5 years old at the time. Everything felt against me, I did not speak the language hardly at all, not knowing anyone, not having friends or family to ask for support. Well, that was me, fortunately God has always been with me, and I met the organization that helps victims, and they told me about this place.

I confess I was very afraid because I had heard negative things about other shelters, but they assured me that here I would be fine with my daughter, and it was like that. Care and Share was the best thing that could have happened to me here, they made me feel protected and supported. They helped me receive mental health therapy for my daughter and also helped me to find a home.





