
























LIVED EXPERIENCE

ESCAPING DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

I FOUND MYSELF TRAPPED IN AN ABUSIVE RELATIONSHIP THAT DRAINED MY SPIRIT AND LEFT ME LIVING IN CONSTANT FEAR. HE, A MONSTER, CONTROLLING EVERY ASPECT OF MY LIFE—WHAT I WORE, WHO I SPOKE TO, AND EVEN HOW I BREATHED AROUND HIM. THE EMOTIONAL ABUSE WAS RELENTLESS, CHIPPING AWAY AT MY SELF–WORTH, I NEEDED TO MAKE THE MOST TERRIFYING YET NECESSARY DECISION OF MY LIFE: TO ESCAPE.

IT WASN'T JUST ABOUT ME. MY DAUGHTER WAS GROWING UP IN A HOUSEHOLD FILLED WITH FEAR AND ANGER. THE DAY HE RAISED HIS HAND TO HER WAS THE DAY SOMETHING INSIDE ME SNAPPED. I KNEW I HAD TO GET OUT, NO MATTER THE COST.

LEAVING WASN'T EASY. ABUSERS MANIPULATE THEIR VICTIMS INTO FEELING POWERLESS, AND I HAD BEEN MADE TO BELIEVE THAT I HAD NOWHERE TO GO AND NO ONE WHO WOULD HELP ME. BUT I REFUSED TO ACCEPT THAT. IN THE DEAD OF NIGHT, WITH ONLY A SMALL BAG OF CLOTHES AND THE WEIGHT OF UNCERTAINTY ON MY SHOULDERS, I FLED WITH MY DAUGHTER.

WALKING INTO THE SHELTER WAS LIKE STEPPING INTO ANOTHER WORLD—ONE WHERE SAFETY AND KINDNESS REPLACED FEAR AND PAIN. THE STAFF WELCOMED US WITH OPEN ARMS, GIVING US WARM MEALS, A SAFE PLACE TO SLEEP, AND MOST IMPORTANTLY, REASSURANCE THAT WE WERE NO LONGER ALONE. FOR THE FIRST TIME IN WHAT FELT LIKE FOREVER, I DIDN'T HAVE TO WATCH MY BACK, MY DAUGHTER AND I COULD SLEEP THROUGH THE NIGHT.

AT CARE AND SHARE, WE WERE NOT JUST GIVEN A ROOF OVER OUR HEADS BUT THE TOOLS TO REBUILD OUR LIVES. I RECEIVED COUNSELING THAT HELPED ME PROCESS THE TRAUMA AND REDISCOVER MY STRENGTH. I ATTENDED SUPPORT GROUPS WHERE I MET PEOPLE WHO HAD WALKED SIMILAR PATHS, EACH OF US FINDING SOLACE IN SHARED EXPERIENCES. THE SHELTER CONNECTED ME WITH LEGAL ADVOCATES WHO GUIDED ME THROUGH THE STEPS OF OBTAINING A RESTRAINING ORDER AND STARTING THE PROCESS OF REBUILDING MY INDEPENDENCE.

MOST IMPORTANTLY, MY DAUGHTER AND I FOUND HOPE. SHE LAUGHED AGAIN, PLAYED WITHOUT FEAR, AND BEGAN TO HEAL FROM THE SCARS OF OUR PAST. I FOUND A JOB, AND A HOME AND STARTED DREAMING ABOUT A FUTURE WHERE I WAS IN CONTROL OF MY OWN LIFE.

LEAVING MY ABUSER WAS THE HARDEST THING I'VE EVER DONE, BUT IT WAS ALSO THE MOST EMPOWERING. THE CARE AND SHARE SHELTER SAVED US IN EVERY WAY IMAGINABLE—NOT JUST BY GIVING US A SAFE PLACE TO STAY BUT BY REMINDING US THAT WE WERE WORTHY OF LOVE, RESPECT, AND A LIFE FREE FROM FEAR. TODAY, MY DAUGHTER AND I ARE SURVIVORS, NOT VICTIMS. WE ARE FREE. AND FOR THAT, I WILL FOREVER BE GRATEFUL.
