LED BY TREATMENT DIRECTOR LEANE LAFRANCE, THE INITIATIVE EMPLOYS A TRAUMA-INFORMED, HARM-REDUCTION, AND DE-ESCALATION PHILOSOPHY TO FOSTER A SAFE AND RESPECTFUL ENVIRONMENT FOR INDIVIDUALS IN NEED.

KEY SERVICES INCLUDE:

- ONSITE INDIVIDUAL AND GROUP THERAPY: TAILORED SUPPORT FOR INDIVIDUALS SEEKING GUIDANCE THROUGH THEIR RECOVERY JOURNEY.
 - MEDICAL ASSESSMENTS & REFERRALS: ENSURING ACCESS TO APPROPRIATE MEDICAL CARE AND TREATMENT OPTIONS.
 - MEDICATION MANAGEMENT: PROVIDING EFFECTIVE MEDICATION MANAGEMENT TO SUPPORT LONG-TERM RECOVERY GOALS.


